Minimum qualifications for candidate:

- Registered Nurse (RN) license
- Associate's Degree or higher
- **⇒** Eight (8) years of relevant healthcare professional experience
- One (1) year of work experience in a long-term care or rehabilitation facility

<u>Application should document</u> the following knowledge, skills and training in <u>effective instruction</u> to help students meet learning standards:

- Experience utilizing a blended learning environment including, but not limited to: use of electronic health records, portable monitors and wearable medical devices, use of drug management technology, automated IV pumps, and smart beds;
